


Jenigami Bird Cage – Pop Up Option 1 - How to attach to the front of a card, inside a card, or scrapbook layout

- Build Jenigami design as per the instructions
- Lay flat with the back of the design facing you
- Fold over the struts that will be on the back of the design so they will lie flat in the opposite direction
- Attached double sided sticky tape to the back flat strut area only, ensuring not to stick any other part of the design
- Remove double sided sticky tape covering, turn design over, and stick to the card or layout
- The Jenigami design will now lie totally flat against the card, and will open out when lifted
















Jenigami Bird Cage – Pop Up Option 2 - How to attach inside a card

- Build Jenigami design as per the instructions
- Cut a small strip of card 4.5 times the length of one of the back struts
- Fold this to make a square of card, using the 0.5 edge to stick together
- Attach two sides of the square to the two back struts of the design
- Attach the other two sides of the square to bottom fold of the card
- The Jenigami design will now lie totally flat when closed, and will open when the card is opened
- NB this method also allows the recipient to easily remove and keep the Jenigami design
- NB for a more rigid structure, use Option 1 instead



Jenigami Bird Cage – Pop Up Option 3 - How to hang from an aperture

- Build Jenigami design as per the instructions
- Cut an aperture from a card which is large enough to display the Jenigami design
- Attach one part of the Jenigami design to the aperture, for the bird cage this is simply the hook at the top, alternatively it could be the bottom central horizon bar
- The Jenigami design will now lie totally flat when closed, and will swing when the card is opened







Jenigami Bird Cage – Pop Up Option 4 – How to pop open from inside the card

- Build Jenigami design as per the instructions
- Line up the opened design perfectly with the centre fold of the card
- Fold the struts at the two outer edges flat
- Or the first folded strut side, use either a small square of card, or a cardstock embellishment, folded in half, and attach half to the flat edge struts and half to the base card
- Fold the Jenigami design flat exactly where it falls after the strut was attached to one side of the card, then attach another square of card, or embellishment, to the struts on the other side, add glue, and then fold the card shut, this will ensure perfect placement of the design
- The Jenigami design will now lie totally flat when closed, and will pop right open when the card is opened
- NB the squares of card attached to the struts can be attached under the design to keep them hidden, but this can be fiddly to master
